Tools required:


- 16mm & 19mm Sockets
- 3, 5 & 6mm Allen
- 10mm Wrench

STEP 1

Remove all wrapping and cut cable ties to lay out all parts: Frame (A), Handles (B) and Grinder Assembly (C).



STEP 2

First, locate the handlebar assembly and remove the nuts from all 4 screws. Use 5mm Allen wrench.



STEP 3

Align and insert the bolts through holes on the upper part of the frame. Attach washer and nuts then tighten to secure the handles. Use 5mm Allen wrench and 10mm wrench.




STEP 4

Locate the grinder assembly and remove just the nuts on both sides.



STEP 5

Insert the grinder in-between the bracket and insert the bolts into the grinder handle threads. The depth stop bracket has 4 holes and can be adjusted to new hole depending on size wheel or stone being used. Use 19mm socket wrench.



STEP 6

Lift the depth-stop bracket up, may need to loosen knob.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

STEP 7

Take the strap and wrap it around the grinder securing it to the other side.



STEP 8

Must be secure but not too tight, there are multiple holes on the strap.




STEP 9

Locate the angle adjustment bracket and loosen bolt allowing it to come apart. Use 6mm Allen wrench and 13mm wrench.



STEP 10

Secure angle adjustment bracket around the grinder handle and trigger area making sure the bolt is activating the trigger (bolt must keep trigger in the "ON" position at all times). Use 6mm Allen wrench.



STEP 11

Remove bolts on the bottom frame assembly. Use 16mm socket wrench.



STEP 12

Remove the single bolt on the grinder assembly (one side will have 2 bolts on the other side will have one).





INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

STEP 13

Loosen the two bolts on the grinder assembly (do not need to remove only loosen). Use 5mm Allen wrench.



STEP 14

Attach bolts on bottom frame assembly through the grinder assembly and tighten. Use 16mm socket wrench.



STEP 15

Insert single bolt on the grinder assembly through the frame and attach nut in interframe.

Use 5mm Allen wrench.



STEP 16

Tighten the two bolts on the grinder assembly and use the nuts to lock in place. Use 5mm Allen wrench



STEP 17

Check to make sure lock collars are tight but make sure they allow handle to spin freely. Use 3mm Allen wrench.



STEP 18

Plug in the grinder to the outlet on the switch box, wrap the extra cord around the holder.






INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

STEP 19

Loosen knobs on both sides of the frame to adjust handle height.



STEP 20

Pull handles out to the desired height and retighten knobs.



STEP 21

To adjust grinder angle, loosen the bolt holder and adjust the knob to the desired angle then retighten bolt holder to keep from moving.



STEP 22

Adjust depth stop by putting the cart on an area adjacent to the material been grinded and adjust the knob to the height desired. The depth stop bracket has 4 holes and can be adjusted to new hole depending on size wheel or stone being used.



STEP 23

The cart has a 2-switch system, you will need to turn on/off switch on the box first.




STEP 24

Now to activate grinder, pull the lever on the handle.
